

Spooky Candle Wrap



If you have an hour, that's all you need to make this Spooky Candle Wrap. Tie around your candle or hurricane to add ghoulish fun to your table centerpiece.

Skill Level: Basic

Supplies:

All Hallows Eve- ADP-70J
1/4 yard Sparkle organza-purple
1/4 yard Sparkle organza-white
1-Spool 1/2" Halloween craft ribbon
Small Hoop
Small Scissors
Assortment of Madeira embroidery thread
Madeira Glow in the Dark embroidery thread
Soldering iron (optional)

Instructions:

1. Together, hoop both pieces of the organza putting the purple on top.
2. Using the embroidery edit function of your machine, load AH18 (spider's web) onto the machine, then load AH19 (spider) onto the machine. Move the spider to the desired place on the web.
3. Using the glow-in-the-dark thread, stitch the spider's web. Stitch the spider in the desired thread color.
4. Remove from hoop. Trim around the outside edge close to the stitching being careful not to cut the stitching.
Note: You can use the soldering iron to trim the excess fabric. This gives a nice clean finish.
5. Repeat this to make enough spider webs to go around your candle or hurricane.
6. From the craft ribbon, cut 1-1 1/2" piece for each 2 spider web pieces to connect together. Cut 2-12" pieces for the ties.
7. Set the machine up for straight stitch sewing. Fold under 1/4" on each end of the 1 1/2" pieces of ribbon. Stitch them to the back side of the spider web pieces to connect them. Repeat to connect all the spider webs.
8. Fold under 1/4" on one end of each of the 12" pieces of ribbon. Stitch one piece to each end of the connected spider webs.

Wrap this around your candle or hurricane to add ghoulish fun to your table centerpiece.
